Here are 10 reasons you should consider joining our PTSA.

- 1 It's good for your child(ren). When parents get connected to the school, children get better grades, do better on tests, and have fewer discipline problems. When you build a relationship with your child's teachers, principal, and office staff, it will be far easier to communicate about any problem (or victory) that occurs throughout the year.
- 2 It's important to the school. Schools are becoming more and more dependent on parent groups. The parent groups are responsible for almost all the school's fundraising revenue. We provide support to teachers and administrators, and we create a caring and supportive atmosphere in the school.
